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#### Four Considerations

- 1) Complexity of the US system drives inconsistent workforce qualifications
- ECE policies may contribute to or ameliorate educational and role stratification by language and ethnicity
- Absence of workforce data reinforces a status quo which often works against children's well-being
- Adult learning environments support or impede teacher practice and development

Conclusions too often drawn from insufficient evidence
